COPARC is a statewide community-based network of services to support adoptive families. We are funded through Promoting Safe and Stable Families Program, Colorado Department of Human Services, Child Welfare Division and in partnership with The Adoption Exchange.

- ♥ For families who live in Colorado and have adopted through child welfare, funds are available to help with needed resources for special needs of children
- ▼ COPARC provided funding to **11** counties or nonprofits who applied for funds in 2013 to directly benefit adoptive families
- ♥ COPARC provides funding to help start support groups for adoptive families

Who else is there to help? COPARC builds networks:

- ▼ AdoptCare Network is a collection of trained professionals who better understand the needs of adoptive families
