## Mission

The mission of the Denver Anti-Trafficking Alliance (DATA) is to create a victim-centered, multidisciplinary response to human trafficking in Denver through trauma-informed victim services, collaborative investigation and prosecution, education and awareness, and public policy advocacy.

## Goals & Objectives

- 1) Develop a comprehensive and collaborative response to all forms of human trafficking in Denver.
- 2) Increase identification of all types of human trafficking victims by having trafficking-informed partner agencies.
- 3) Enhance service provision for victims of human trafficking to ensure that victims are provided with appropriate, trauma-informed services.
- 4) Enhance investigation and prosecution of human trafficking cases to ensure that investigations and prosecutions are victim-centered and trauma-informed while prosecuting traffickers to the furthest extent of the law.
- 5) Promote community education and awareness on human trafficking.
- 6) Improve legislation on human trafficking for the state of Colorado.
- 7) Leverage existing and additional funding to provide a victim-centered investigations and prosecutions and comprehensive services to victims of trafficking.

## DATA Committees

**Victim Services Committee** – establishing victim services protocol of providers in Denver

**Training & Education Committee** – working on city-wide strategic training and awareness

**Public Policy Committee (state-wide)** – helping to develop public policy at the state level

**Juvenile Sex Trafficking Working Group** – coordinating the response to juvenile sex trafficking in the judicial system

**Demand Reduction Committee** – working on reducing demand for commercial sex through preventative education and awareness
